Internationally recognised experts with a clear research focus on empirical educational science and demonstrating a significant interest in education, learning and interventions in vocational education and training in organizations are especially invited to apply. Relevant and international high-quality publications are expected.

Due to the increasing importance of (fostering) physical and psychological health in educational science, experience in this area, for instance by focusing on (the development and evaluation of measures for) fostering health, and/or fostering professionals in relevant occupations and domains is highly appreciated.

Teaching needs to be carried out in particular in the existing studies Bachelor Educational Science, Master Educational Science, and in Educational Science in Teacher Education. The professorship is bound to Art. 3 § 5 of the Bavarian Concordat.

Successfull experience in acquisition and the willingness to apply for funding for and work in transdisciplinary empirical research projects with colleagues inside and outside the university is expected. Initiating and developing new (inter)national studies is expected, as is experience in governance.

Prerequisites for taking up the position are, in addition to the general conditions from public sector employment law: a completed university degree, pedagogic suitability, and particular aptitude for academic work, generally shown by a doctoral degree, as well as additional academic achievements, such as a Habilitation or an equivalent research record. Scientific research experience gained outside of a university environment, or while employed as a Junior Professor, will also be taken into consideration and may be considered equivalent to a formal academic qualification.

The University of Regensburg is particularly committed to reconciling family and working life (for more information, see http://www.uni-regensburg.de/familienservice). To fulfill the equality directive and increase the number of female professors, applications from qualified women are explicitly encouraged.

In case of essentially similar suitability, applicants with severe disabilities will be preferentially selected.

The prerequisites for appointment under civil servant law are based on the provisions of the Bavarian Public Service Code (BayBG) and the Bavarian University Staff Act (BayHIG).
